

GENERAL RULES

23. No Alcoholic Beverages; No Drugs; No Discharging of Firearms on the fair grounds except (when concerning firearms) as part of a fair event.
24. Any persons detected molesting exhibits will be dealt with according to the law.
25. Exhibits may compete in one class only.
26. **EXHIBITS MAY NOT BE REMOVED BEFORE 9:00 P.M. SATURDAY. Exhibits left after 10:00 P.M. will become property of the association unless prior arrangements have been made. THIS IS A STATE REGULATION.**
27. Ribbons will be given for first, second and third place except where otherwise indicated.
28. Money prizes will be given as listed in the catalog. If varieties are exhibited which are not listed in catalog, they will be entered as additional classes and judged accordingly.
29. Indoor Exhibits will be on display in the high school building. School will open Tuesday 5:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M., Wednesday 4:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M., Thursday 9:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M., Friday 9:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M. and Saturday 9:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M.
30. **ALL PREMIUM CHECKS WILL BE MAILED**
31. All horses must have Coggins test and Rabies vaccine.
32. The Board of Directors will not be held responsible for damage resulting from errors or omissions in this book.
33. There will be no self competition in any department, except livestock*.
34. All concessionaires must be contracted with the Jamestown Community Fair for the privilege of selling on the fair grounds. Concessionaires must comply strictly with all Federal, State, Municipal and Fair Board's health rules which will be rigidly enforced. The fair reserves the right to cancel any contract for the violation of any rules of the fair or rules governing the fair.
35. There shall be NO laser pointers, potato guns, or knives sold or in one's possession anywhere on the fair grounds.
36. Pets of any kind (domestic or exotic) will not be allowed on the grounds except to aid the handicapped or to be part of an exhibit or scheduled entertainment. Owners of pets and or animals on the fair grounds will be responsible for any damages to persons or property.
37. Inside the school, school regulations prevail. Parents are responsible for the actions of their children. All children, patrons or those accompanying renters, will not be permitted to cause distress to others.
38. **No vehicles on the fair grounds.**
39. All camper fees have been raised to \$60, **except those with livestock, which remains at \$30. All campers should be preregistered.**

SPECIAL NOTE: ALL PREMIUM CHECKS WILL BE MAILED

All animals and property of exhibitor are at the sole risk of the exhibitor and neither the Association nor any committee, officer or employee thereof shall be liable for any loss, damage, or injury to any animals or other property of any exhibitor or to any exhibitor, or to any employee of any exhibitor while on the Fair Grounds, and each exhibitor agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Association from and against any loss, damage or injury to him or to any employee of his or to his animals or other property while on the Fair Grounds, and each exhibitor agrees to assume all liability for and to indemnify and save harmless the Association from and against any and all claims, demands, expenses or liability whatsoever to or arising from any injury, or damage to any person or property caused by any animals entered by the exhibitor or any employee of his. Entries and exhibits are received upon these terms only.

It is the full intention and desire to pay all premiums as advertised in the Premium List. Should any contingency arise whereby the receipts of the Association are short, the Board will reserve the right to pay pro rata upon the gross receipts after deducting the expenses, and that sum shall discharge the obligation of the Association for the current year.

No persons having entered an exhibit for competition will be allowed to make a substitution of animals or otherwise change the entry after five days prior to the opening of the fair, except as noted in next paragraph. Prize ribbons and Commendation cards of Awards may be displayed during the exposition.

Exhibits that have been erroneously entered may, at the discretion of the management be transferred to their proper classes previous to the judging but if such classes shall have been judged they shall not be reopened.

No animals can be entered or shown unless they have been recorded in the recognized books of record for their respective breed. Registration papers must accompany all animals going into the show ring.

To be eligible for competition whether singly or in groups, animals must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at the time of showing, except where otherwise specified. Where animals were not bred by exhibitors, registration certificates and transfers must be produced showing that the animals were registered in the exhibitor's name on or before the date on which entries closed. All registration certificates will be checked by the management before the animals may enter the judging ring.

All animals must conform to the health rules and regulations.
